The Greensboro Children's Museum (GCM) is a nonprofit that works to serve all children through fun, interactive experiences that contribute to their growth and development. The assistant teacher will spend four or five weeks per session immersed in this unique atmosphere aiding summer camp teachers with week-long, themed day camps. There are two positions available for each session:

- **First Session:** June 5th – June 30th 2017
- **Second Session:** July 10th – August 11th 2017
- An assistant teacher may elect to participate in both sessions.

The summer camp assistant teacher may be responsible for the following:

- Assist with programming for preschool – 5th graders
- Be responsible for groups of up to 10 children at time
- Serve as a positive role model for campers through cheerful attitude, loving and compassionate demeanor, ability to be flexible, and strong work ethic
- Facilitate opportunities for informal learning and skill-building
- Work 30 hours a week for four weeks (Session 1) or five weeks (Session 2) during sessions listed above
