The Greensboro Children's Museum (GCM) is a nonprofit that works to serve all children through fun, interactive experiences that contribute to their growth and development. During the summer our educators craft creative experiences for campers ages 4 - 11 years. The Summer Camp Teacher will spend nine weeks working alongside the Lead Educator and guest instructors to carry out our week-long, themed day camps.

 - May 28th – June 1st, 9am-1pm
 - July 2nd – 3rd, 9am-1pm
 - **First Session:** June 4th – June 29th, 30-40 hours a week
 - **Second Session:** July 9th – August 10th, 30-40 hours a week

The Summer Camp Teacher may be responsible for the following:

- Preparation and organization of materials
- Leading students in themed activities
- Fostering an environment of informal learning and skill-building
- Serving as a positive role model for campers through cheerful attitude, loving and compassionate demeanor, ability to be flexible, and strong work ethic
