Education Internship



The Greensboro Children's Museum (GCM) is a hands-on, interactive museum for children, their families and teachers. The Museum is designed to inspire learning through play in a fun, energetic and safe environment for children up to 10 years of age. Interns will spend the semester immersed in this unique atmosphere assisting staff with field trips for K-3rd grade students, Museum floor programs, and special events. Depending on the interests of the intern, there is also the possibility of participating in music, drama, and arts and crafts activities and other special projects.

There is one position available for each semester:

First Session: September - November

Second Session: March - May

Interns are responsible for the following:

- Assisting with museum field trips and programs for children of all ages
 - Independently leading lessons for groups of up to 12 children
 - Aiding museum educators with program development and/or special projects
 - Planning and executing crafts, games, and other activities with guests
 - **Must be available to work from 8:30am to 12:30pm on at least two days per week. Additional hours on afternoons and weekends are also available.**
 - Minimum hours per week: 8
 - Maximum number of hours per week: 20
