Brownie BETWEEN EARTH AND SKY - FIREFLY AWARD:

Step 1: Seed Exploration

The girls explore living the Girl Scout Law and expand their knowledge of seeds. We'll learn about how seeds vary in size, shape, color and texture, and use a variety of different seeds to create a collage.

Next, we'll head outside into The Edible Schoolyard to plant seeds in the garden, helping to take care of Planet Earth.

Step 2: Discovering Similarities and Differences

Girls discuss similarities and differences, considering their own special skills and the unique traits of plants in the garden. The girls explore The Edible Schoolyard to find different textures and make a rubbing (i.e. tree bark, stone).

Step 3: Identification of Special Skills

Each girl identifies one of her unique abilities, and presents her garden artwork and unique ability to the group. Through this process, we'll practicing public speaking skills and work on building self-confidence.
