### Summer Camp

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The Greensboro Children's Museum (GCM) is a nonprofit that works to serve all children through fun, interactive experiences that contribute to their growth and development. Interns will spend four or five weeks per session immersed in this unique atmosphere assisting summer camp teachers with week-long, themed day camps. There are two positions available for each session:

- **First Session:** June 5<sup>th</sup> – June 30<sup>th</sup> 2017
- **Second Session:** July 10<sup>th</sup> – August 11<sup>th</sup> 2017
- Interns may also elect to participate in both sessions.

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#### **Interns may be responsible for the following:**

- Assisting with programming for preschool – 5th graders
- Be responsible for groups of up to 10 children at time
- Serve as a positive role model for campers through cheerful attitude, loving and compassionate demeanor, ability to be flexible, and strong work ethic
- Facilitate opportunities for informal learning and skill-building
- Work 30 hours a week for four weeks (Session 1) or five weeks (Session 2) during sessions listed above
