This position works with a team of educators to deliver educational programs, field trips, fun activities, and exceptional guest experiences at the Greensboro Children's Museum. The ideal candidate is positive, high-energy, engaging, and thrives in a lively environment. Further, this candidate should have a strong interest in early childhood development and the work of The Edible Schoolyard. This person will spend most of their time immersed in food education programming at the Museum.

Position Schedule: This position is classified as non-exempt. It is a part-time position ranging between 8-15 hours per week. Dates: February 27th – May 24th

Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 8:30am – 12:30pm and occasional weeknight and weekend evenings from 4:00 – 8:00pm.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Teaching indoor and outdoor field trip programs to large school groups
- Assisting the Chef Educator in cooking classes for kids, teens, and adults
- Initiating positive play in Museum exhibits
- Conducting lessons and activities for guests of all ages
- Conducting scheduled and unscheduled tours
- Assisting the Gardener with garden tasks

Aside from the aforementioned roles and responsibilities, all GCM staff members are asked to provide assistance when needed to support the GCM team in furthering its mission of promoting learning through play. This may include, but is not limited to, providing back-up on other GCM programming and maintaining exhibits during operating hours.
