## 2019 Summer Camp Assistant Teacher

### Education

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The Greensboro Children's Museum (GCM) is a nonprofit that works to serve all children through fun, interactive experiences that contribute to their growth and development. The assistant teacher will spend four or five weeks per session immersed in this unique atmosphere aiding summer camp teachers with week-long, themed day camps. GCM Camps engage kids in science, art, music, robotics, and more! There are two camp sessions:

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- **First Session:** June 3<sup>rd</sup> – June 28<sup>th</sup> 2019
  - **Second Session:** July 8<sup>th</sup> – August 9<sup>th</sup> 2019
  - An assistant teacher may elect to be considered for participation in both sessions.

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#### **The summer camp assistant teacher may be responsible for the following:**

- Assist with programming for preschool – 6<sup>th</sup> graders
- Be responsible for groups of up to 10 children at time
- Serve as a positive role model for campers through cheerful attitude, loving and compassionate demeanor, ability to be flexible, and strong work ethic
- Facilitate opportunities for informal learning and skill-building
- Work 30 hours a week for four weeks (Session 1) or five weeks (Session 2) during sessions listed above

Excitement and curiosity about the work of the Greensboro Children's Museum  
High school graduate  
Quick learner and independent thinker
