

BIRTHDAY PARTY OVERVIEW

What is included:

- A 3-hour reservation for up to 25 guests. (days vary by availability)
- Access to a private party room (including tables, chairs & table cloths), all indoor exhibits, outdoor climbers, and the garden/patio.
- A Greensboro Children's Museum staff member will be available for the duration of your party to help check-in guests, answer questions, and help encourage new policies/procedures for all attending guests.
- Free parking for you and all the guests.

Reservations:

Reservations are required. Please call 336.574.2898 ext. 309 or email sclifford@gcmuseum.com. Reservations need to be finalized and booked at least 7 days in advance of the desired date.

Payment information:

The cost of a 3-hour birthday party reservation is \$250 plus sales tax. A deposit of \$50 is due at the time of booking, and the remainder is due the day before the party.

Refreshments/Decorations:

You are welcome to bring your own food, snacks, and drinks. However, these items must stay in your designated party room. You will not have access to a kitchen or refrigerator, so you may want to bring a cooler and ice. If you would like to bring balloons and table decorations, please feel free to do so. You will be responsible for cleaning up any decorations and food items that you bring.

What you will need to provide:

A guest list of all attendees so GCM staff can check in guests upon arrival.

Policies to be aware of:

Face coverings must be worn for the entirety of your stay. They are required for anyone 5 years or older, and strongly encouraged for 3-4 years old. Closed toe shoes are required while climbing on the outdoor Play Plaza. We are currently requiring all guests undergo a temperature check and a symptom screening questionnaire upon entering the museum.
